For this event, the Organizing Committee has defined a cost plan that includes:

The prices for accompanying children under 4 years, infants of 4-10 years and adults who do not attend academic activities are also calculated. There is an additional fee for participants who wish to stay in a single or double room.

Besides the formal program, we aim to offer an informal atmosphere where the Latin American acarological community and special guests from North America and Europe can get to know each other, exchange ideas, and start collaborations.
